

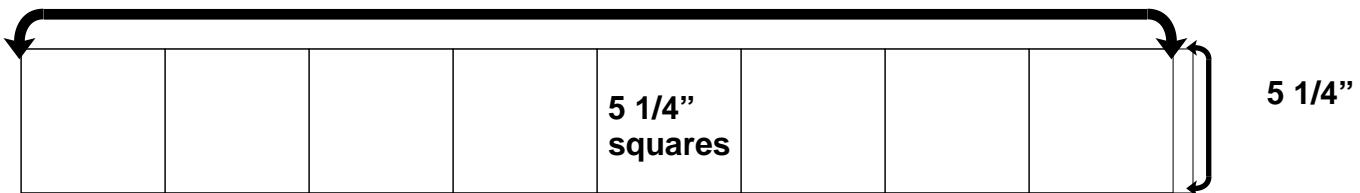
The instructions in the cutting instructions box on page 10, second bullet, currently read:

Cut 1 strip 4 7/8" wide into 9 squares.... etc...

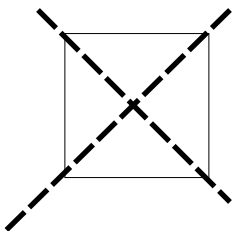
*This should be cut 5 1/4"*. Because the size was written in the book incorrectly, you will only be able to cut 8 squares from one strip. Cut the ninth square from a scrap of your background fabric so you have a total of nine squares. All nine squares should cut to 5 1/4" square.

Then cut each square with an "X" To yield the quarter square triangles that will be inset into the diamonds as follows:

42" is needed to cut 8 squares

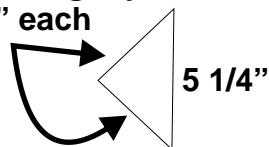


5 1/4" squares cut 9th square from a scrap of background fabric



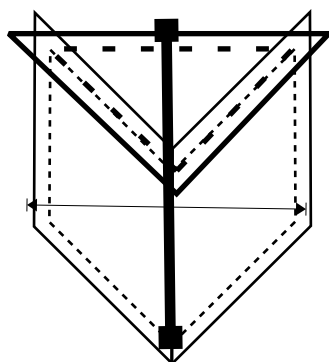
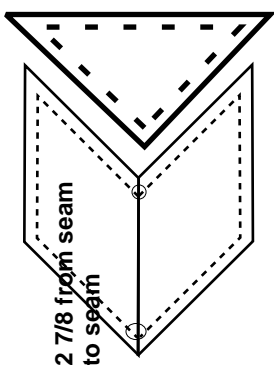
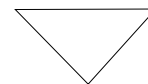
Cut each square diagonally from corner to corner with an "X" to yield four triangles for inserting into the paired diamonds.

these two sides measure just slightly under 3 3/4" each



Your 9 squares cut into 4 triangles each will yield a total of 36 triangle units.

Once the triangles have been inset into the paired diamonds:



from top edge of sewn unit to the point at the bottom where the SEAMS JOIN AT A POINT the measurement is 5 1/8"

width of paired diamonds is 4 1/2"

You are going to have to allow for the 1/8" difference in size in the seam allowance.

According to my directions the modified 9-patch from raw edge to raw edge should measure 7 3/4" but it really SHOULD BE 7 3/8" to be a perfect fit. If you center the difference so each "end" is 1/16th off, it will fit perfectly.
